**DISTRICT OF PORT HARDY
BYLAW 01-2010**

A bylaw authorizing the use of the Municipal Ticket Information System

WHEREAS pursuant to section 264 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the District of Port Hardy may, by bylaw,

- (a) designate a bylaw that falls outside a category of bylaws prescribed by regulation under section 273 (b) of the *Community Charter*,
- (b) designate as a bylaw enforcement officer a person who comes within a class of persons prescribed by regulation under section 273 (c) of the *Community Charter*,
- (c) authorize the use of any word or expression on a ticket issued under subsection 264 (2) of the *Community Charter* to designate an offence against a bylaw, and
- (d) for the purpose of section 265 (1) (a) of the *Community Charter*, set a fine not greater than the amount prescribed by regulation.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Port Hardy, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw No. 01-2010.
2. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A to this Bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 264 of the *Community Charter*.
3. The persons who act in the job position or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule A to this bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers pursuant to Section 264 (1) (b) of the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A opposite the respective job positions.
4. Pursuant to Section 264 (1) (c) of the *Community Charter*, the words or expressions set forth in Column 2 of Schedules B through S to this Bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section numbers appearing in Column 1 of Schedules B through S opposite the respective words or expressions.
5. Pursuant to Section 265 1 (a) of the *Community Charter*, the fine amount set forth in Column 3 of Schedules B through S to this Bylaw is the fine amount that corresponds to the section number and words or expressions set out in Columns 1 and 2 of Schedules B through T opposite the fine amount.

Severability

6. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

Repeal

7. District of Port Hardy Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw No. 13-2008 and all amendments to it are hereby repealed.
