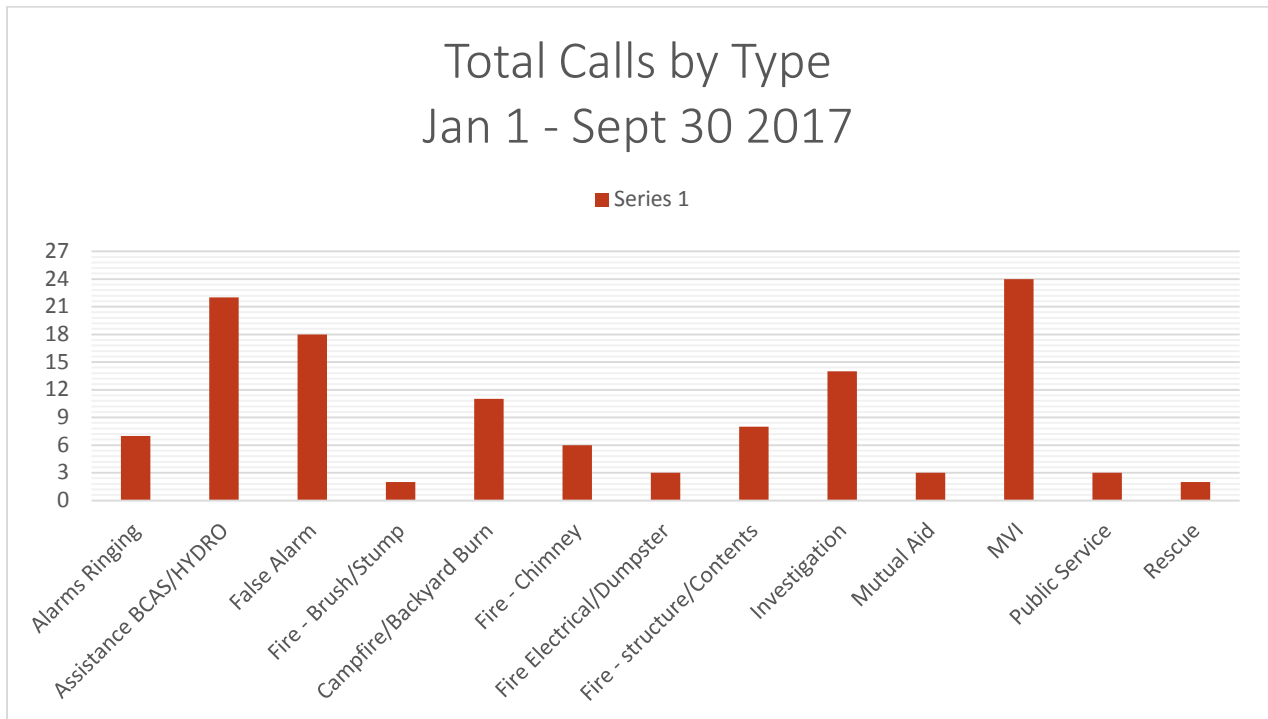
Good Evening Mayor Bood and Council,

Port Hardy Fire Rescue's 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly report combined.

This year has shown major changes in Port Hardy Fire Rescue's Membership, Equipment and Training which I will outline for you now.

## Calls

This year we've had 134 calls totalling 1160 hours attendance at incidents. Last Quarter there were 63 incidents totalling 557.5 hours of service to attend calls. Our new Ladder 17 has been in used at 4 calls since purchase including; 1 roof fire, 1 Chimney fire, 1 rescue off the Highschool roof, and most significantly 1 apartment fire in which Ladder 17 played an integral roll in stopping the fire from spreading to other units.

### Training

Some Training completed this year is as follows:

- Beyond Hoses and Helmets
- Interior Team Leader
- VIERA Evaluators Course
- First Aid and Transportation
- S-100 Basic Fire Suppression
- Live burn at Tslquate Reserve – we had members from all Mutual Aid towns participate in this event.

Practice nights consisted of training on Ladders and roofs, 5-man evolutions, Ladder 17 orientation and practice, SCBA training, Search Drills, Low Slope Rescue and Auto X. There is a total of 1983 training hours this year.

### Membership

Currently Port Hardy Fire Rescue has 19 Officers and Firefighters, 1 Rookie, 2 Recruits and 2 Staff Members. We have 1 officer on medical leave. Membership is at an all time critical low.

We are investing a great deal of time and money on a recruitment drive in which we have printed up flyers to be posted at local businesses. On Wednesday October 11, 2017 members are going door to door at the beach to invite potential new members to come to our Open House on Saturday October 14, 2017 @ 5pm at Hall #2.

PHFR welcomed back 2 past members: FF Gregory Smith and FF Allan Mose. We promoted Gavin Texmo and Brand Tolmie to Lieutenant Officer.
