RECREATIONAL FIRE: is a campfire and means the burning of wood for recreational purposes in a permanent outdoor fireplace, barbecue or fire pit not larger than 60 centimetres in diameter that is designed and constructed to confine the fire and is suitable for such a purpose. YOU CANNOT BURN AT ANY TIME: tires, treated lumber, plastics, railway ties, drywall, manure, rubber, demolition waste, domestic waste, paint asphalt products, hazardous waste fuel and lubricant containers, tar paper, biomedical waste or Any Prohibited Material as defined in the Open Burning Smoke Control Regulation.


