??? BACKYARD BURNING???

FROM APRIL 30 TO SEPTEMBER 30 ONLY RECREATIONAL FIRES ARE ALLOWED IN THE DISTRICT OF PORT HARDY

NO OTHER BURNING IS PERMITTED

- All Provincial Fire Bans, effective within the Coastal Fire Centre, shall apply within the District boundaries.
- Port Hardy is NOT in the fog zone



RECREATIONAL FIRE: is a campfire and means the burning of wood for recreational purposes in a permanent outdoor fireplace, barbecue or fire pit not larger than 60 centimetres in diameter that is designed and constructed to confine the fire and is suitable for such a purpose. **YOU CANNOT BURN AT ANY TIME:** tires, treated lumber, plastics, railway ties, drywall, manure, rubber, demolition waste, domestic waste, paint asphalt products, hazardous waste fuel and lubricant containers, tar paper, biomedical waste or Any Prohibited Material as defined in the Open Burning Smoke Control Regulation.

- 2017 Retroactive Homeowner Grant: Didn't claim 2017 Home Owner Grant? You have until December 31, 2018 submit a retroactive claim.

BYLAW 1027-2014 Sec.5(c) No person shall deposit garbage or trade waste for pick-up with the garbage or trade waste of another person, or deposit garbage or trade waste in regulation garbage receptacles or standard containers owned by another person without that owner's permission. Fines can be assessed of up to \$250.00

FOX'S DISPOSAL TRANSFER STATION**

Residential garbage and ferrous metals can be dropped off during business hours: Tuesday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday 1:00pm to 4:00 pm
