Request for Quotations

Supply and installation of a new compressor and SCBA compressed air, cascade filling station system.

Port Hardy Fire Rescue currently has in place, a 4500psi compressor, three (3) 5000psi storage tanks and three (3) 4500psi storage tanks, plumbed into an automatic cascade system of three banks of two cylinders each, as well as a two-cylinder SCBA fill station, rated to fill 2216psi and 4500psi. An additional 4500psi whip was added to allow filling of SCUBA style cylinders outside the blast chamber.

The District of Port Hardy on behalf of Port Hardy Fire Rescue is requesting submissions for the supply, delivery and install to the District of Port Hardy Fire Hall #1 8890 Central Avenue Port Hardy, BC, for: **A new compressor and SCBA compressed air, cascade filling station system.**

Supply and Install:

- A new 6000psi compressor.
- Six (6) new 6000psi storage cylinders to be used in a cascade system.
- A two (2) cylinder blast chamber fill station, capable of 2216psi and 4500psi filling, able to hold both standard sized SCBA cylinders and standard "aluminum S80" SCUBA cylinders, with standard SCUBA yoke connectors and SCBA connectors. This fill station would be used in tandem with the current fill station currently in operation.
- Delivery and installation costs.

The District is open to suggestion or recommendation from suppliers and technicians in regard to other options that may reduce costs and/or increase efficiency of the system, such as reusing current components, as long as there is no added risk to operability or safety. For example, adding the current 5000psi and 4500psi storage cylinders to the system to increase the cascade capacity. Adding any optional suggestions such as this to the quote will be taken into consideration with the entirety of the quote provided.

This is a Request for Quotations only. By requesting quotations, the District of Port Hardy does not intend to enter into, and shall not be considered to have entered into, contractual relations upon the submission of a quotation by any person and no "Contract A" shall be formed between the District of Port Hardy any supplier upon the submission of a quotation. Without limiting the foregoing, the District shall not be obligated in any manner whatsoever to any supplier until a written agreement for the performance of the work herein contemplated has been duly executed.

Quotations will be evaluated based on, price and other factors, as determined by the District of Port Hardy's purchasing policy.
