- We prepare articles and social media posts to help educate.



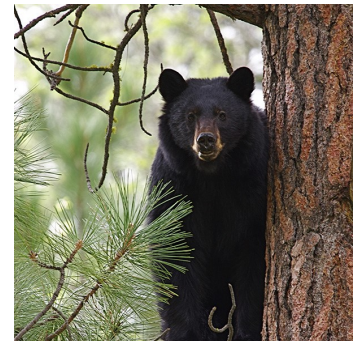
What we don't do:
