2020 PROPERTY TAX & HOMEOWNER GRANT INFORMATION

Property taxes were due July 2nd, with any outstanding balance subject to a 10% penalty. For the 2020 taxation year, due to COVID-19 pandemic, the 10% penalty will be applied to outstanding balances after September 30, 2020.

Homeowner Grant: If you qualify, you must submit the grant application either online at www.porthardy.ca or bring the completed form to the Municipal Hall by December 31, 2020.

2019 Retroactive Homeowner Grant: Didn't claim the 2019 Homeowner Grant? You have until December 31, 2020 to submit a retroactive claim.

PROPERTY TAX SALE

Properties with delinquent taxes on September 28, 2020 will be sold at tax sale on that date at 10 AM.

WATER - SEWER - GARBAGE - RECYCLING 2020 RESIDENTIAL UTILITY RATES

Utilities for the 2nd quarter (April/May/June) will be billed in July. Due date will be August 15th (or later depending on when bills are issued).

SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING \$274.90 per quarter SENIORS SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING

\$206.19 per quarter

When paid by the due date

Seniors 65 years & over may be eligible for a discount.

Council Special Resolution March 24, 2020 in response to the COVI-19 pandemic:

- Extension of seniors discount on any portion of 2020 invoices if paid by November 30, 2020.
- Defer the application of a penalty of 2.5% on any outstanding balance until November 30, 2020.

RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE DEPOT At the Public Works Yard

Reminder, do not dispose of construction waste or any other materials than approved yard waste materials.

PERMITTED MATERIALS



Grass and hedge clippings

Branch and tree prunnings up to 2") in diameter in bundles up to 4.5' Long



MATERIALS NOT PERMITTED

- Stumps & roots
- Soil & rocks
- Wood chips, pallets or wood over 2" in diameter
- Bags, empty or full

Commercial landscaping and yard maintenance operators are allowed a **LIMITED USE** of this facility providing:

- Operator holds a valid District of Port Hardy business licence to provide residential yard maintenance.
- Operator holds a commercial maintenance service operators permit (may be obtained from the District).
- Material disposed is collected from a residential property within the District of Port Hardy.
- Materials collected are not from commercial properties, trailer parks, apartment completes, multifamily and/or strata residential development properties.

Non-approved materials have been disposed at the depot that are not permitted and are subject to fines at the disposal facility.
