Port Hardy Election 2022





Are you eligible to vote at the 2022 general election on October 15, 2022? Is your name on the current list of electors?

If you are not sure you can find out by calling or visiting the District of Port Hardy office, 7360 Columbia Street 250-949-6665. The office is open from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays).

Advance elector registrations will be accepted at the District of Port Hardy office until 4:30 pm on Tuesday August 23, 2022. Except for registrations on voting days, elector registrations will not be accepted during the period August 24, 2022 to October 15, 2022

ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

RESIDENT ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for general voting; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- be a resident of the District of Port Hardy on the day of registration; and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day for general voting; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- a registered owner of real property in the District of Port Hardy voting area for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- the only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust;
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law; and
- if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.
