NOTICE OF NOMINATION

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the District of Port Hardy that nominations for the offices of:

Mayor – one (1) to be elected

Councillor – six (6) to be elected

**School Trustee – three (3) to be elected
(School District No. 85 - Trustee Electoral Area 1)**

QUALIFICATIONS

A person is qualified to be nominated for, be elected to, and to hold office as Mayor, Councillor or School Trustee if that person is:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 15, 2022;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months (April 14, 2022) immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS

Beginning August 30th, 2022 until the close of general voting for the election on October 15, 2022, a copy of the list of registered electors will be available for public inspection, at the Port Hardy Municipal Hall located at 7360 Columbia Street Port Hardy during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays.

Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that they will not inspect the list, make copies, or use the information included in the list except for the purposes of Part 3 – Electors and Elections of the *Local Government Act*.

REQUEST TO OMIT OR OBSCURE

An elector may request that their address or other personal information about them be omitted from or obscured on the list of electors. The elector must contact the Chief Election Officer or the Deputy Election Officer to make this request

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the *Local Government Act* until 4:00 pm on September 9, 2022. An objection must be in writing and an objection may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector of the Municipality and only on the basis that a person whose name appears on the list of electors has died or is not qualified to register as an elector of the Municipality.
