

Third Party Reporting

If you have been sexually assaulted in BC, you may be able to report the crime through a third party so that you can remain anonymous to the police. *(There are no time limitations on 3rd party reports)*

What is Third Party Reporting?

Third Party Reporting is when you want to provide information about a sexual assault but want to remain anonymous. A Third Party Reporting agent provides information about your sexual assault to the police on your behalf.

This option is generally offered to those 19 years and older.

Why Report?

Sexual assault is one of the most under-reported crimes.

This means that violent predators may be operating across areas in BC and police have little to no information to aid them in protecting citizens.

Third Party Reporting provides people who have been sexually assaulted the opportunity to give information about what happened to authorities in an anonymous, empowering, positive, and controlled way. *By making a 3rd party report, you are helping to protect others as well as supporting your own healing journey.*

What happens after I make a Third Party Report?

The third party agent may refer you to local and relevant support services to aid in your healing journey.

Third party agent will keep your name confidential and provide the police with the information that you have given about what happened.

Once police receive the Third Party Report, they will assign a police file number and enter the information provided into their database.

Police will provide the Third Party agent with the file number so that they may pass it on to you.

Police may also ask the Third Party agent to request further information about what happened. The Third Party agent will act as bridge between you and the police throughout the process.
